Hockney 4 Trip to Westminster Abbey

On **Thursday 9th May** Hockney 4 are invited to visit Westminster Abbey.

In response to David Hockney (our class artist) designing a stained-glass window at Westminster Abbey as a gift for The Queen, I have organised a visit to observe the window and learn more.

During the visit, we will have a guided tour of the Abbey, allowing children to learn about all aspects of the religious site, including the new window. We will be eating lunch in the Cloisters, followed by a bespoke workshop where children will design and create their own miniature stained-glass window.

The class and accompanying staff/parents will be leaving school by 10:00 am so your child needs to **arrive at school at the usual time of 8:40am**. The workshop session will finish at 2:45pm. Please note that we will return to school **at the later time of 3:45pm**. The children and adults will be travelling via London Underground; any updates or delays regarding travel times will be communicated via the school office.

There is a voluntary contribution of **£5.60** ; this will cover the cost of the guided tour and bespoke workshop. Payments are only accepted through Parent Pay. **Children will need to bring a packed lunch** – no fizzy drinks, glass bottles or sweets please. **NO NUTS or NUT PRODUCTS**.
