FOUNDATION PLACE ADMISSION CRITERIA

If you wish for your child to be considered under this category please fill out the Foundation Place Clergy reference form that you should ask your Priest or Minister to complete, and send the completed form to the school by the published deadline. In allocating the Foundation places, we will give priority in each band to:

1. Children who are committed* members of an Anglican Church;
2. Children who are committed* members of Churches or Chapels of other Christian denominations defined as those identified with "Churches Together in Britain and Ireland" or who are a member of the Evangelical Alliance.

*'Committed' means attendance by a child and parent/ guardian/ carer at a Church at least twice a month for a minimum period of two years immediately before the date of application. The only exception will be those families who have recently moved and can provide a Priest/ Minister's letter to confirm committed attendance at a different church.
